### Quiz Questions and Free Editing

Zaption, Educanon, Edpuzzle

#### Zaption

[Zaption](http://www.zaption.com/) – <http://www.zaption.com/>

**What it does:** Add quiz questions, images, links or text. Trim the video. Combine multiple videos. Review and analyze responses. Students do not need to create an account to access – they just enter their name. You can have immediate feedback for multiple choice questions.

**See quiz results:** Sign into Zaption. Select tour (a tour means the video with your Zaption edits). Show analytics - (Click on analytics in upper right, click on viewers and responses.)

**Privacy:** privacy settings available if upgrade to pro account.

## Educanon

[Educanon](http://www.educanon.com/) - <http://www.educanon.com/>.

**What It Does:** Add quiz questions, crop video, insert images, links or text. You can have immediate feedback for multiple choice questions. You can require students to log in or not. A unique feature is the students cannot fast forward through the video to answer the questions. (That feature is on the for-fee version of Zaption, not the free one.) The teacher can review and analyze responses (Click on Monitor, click on the lesson).

## Edpuzzle

[Edpuzzle](https://edpuzzle.com/) - <https://edpuzzle.com/>.

**What it does:** Trim video, add questions, add voiceovers. Teacher can review and analyze responses

## Camtasia

<https://tegr.it/y/1j02n> - Video on how to insert popups and quizzes into Camtasia. Import whatever video clip you want to use.

**To create pop-ups and hotspots** – use Callouts. Import an audio file if you want a popping sound.

**Insert an image** – import a file then insert into timeline

**To insert quiz questions** – use Quizzing button to add quiz. You can choose to show the correct answers or not. Publish to Screencast.com.

**See quiz results:** You are emailed student quiz results once a day.

**Privacy:** can set [Screencast.com](https://www.screencast.com) folder as hidden, password protected, public or authenticated.

## Video Annotation and Discussion

### TedEd

<http://ed.ted.com/>

**What it does:** Creates an interactive lesson with a video, multiple choice questions, resources for further study, discussion board and final thought. Can include some or all of these. Students must log in to take the lesson.

**Privacy** – Your lesson can be listed and discoverable by the TedEd community or not.

**Example:** <http://ed.ted.com/on/S9VheLVi> (Researching Court Rules on WestlawNext)

**See quiz results:** Click on your photo in upper left, click on Lessons. Under the lesson click on Show Student Work. Teded also sends an email when students add to the discussion.

### Vialogues

<https://vialogues.com/>

**What it does:** For different points in the video, create discussion and poll questions. Comments can be placed at different points in the timeline. Students must create an account to view the video.

**Example:** <https://vialogues.com/vialogues/play/22006/#external> (Marijuana in Ohio)

**See quiz results:** Creator can log in to Vialogues, click the wheel below the video and see the poll results

**Privacy:** You can set the Vialogue to be public or require moderator permission to join

Can enter URL of any video file

## **Close Captioning**

### **Youtube (for your Youtube videos)**

Edit Youtube's automatic close captioning

Video Manager>Edit button next to video>subtitles &cc>click on caption track to edit

Type in closed captioning or add close captioning using a transcript

### **Amara**

Free software for close captioning

Add captioning even to videos you do not own
